About the Arrangement

“Hark! The Herald Angels Sing” is one of the most oft sung pieces of festive Christmas music, composed by Felix Mendelssohn to the words of Charles Wesley. This Brass Quintet transcription, based on W. H. Cummings' adaptation, features arrangements in the standard hymnal key of G Major and an alternate in F Major and includes the composer's descant for trumpet for the final verse.

About the Arranger

Bill Schuetter earned a baccalaureate degree in instrumental music education from DePaul University in 1976, studying conducting with the legendary Dr. Thomas Fabish. For nine years he performed in Chicago's Holy Name Cathedral Gallery Singers, also forming and conducting the Cathedral Brass Ensemble
