

## **About the Composition**

This short, single movement composition, lasting just over three minutes was written especially for the Student String Ensemble, directed by Gary Hodges, at C. C. M. S. Even though it is written in the E Major pentatonic scale, it is able to utilize the C# minor pentatonic scale as well. The various melodies that are woven together evoke unmistakable images of the early American life of Appalachia.

## **About the Composer**

Composer/pianist Kenneth Piotrowski was born in Michigan and raised in the Greater Detroit area. He began his musical studies on the piano with Ruth Waara at age five and remained with her for the next 15 years. By age eight, instruction in theory and harmony, which continued for 12 years were added. These were soon augmented by courses in counterpoint and composition. Still later, vocal training ensued. To date, he has composed over 450 compositions. Although equally at home composing for full orchestra, the vast majority are chamber music. Piotrowski currently resides in a small, very small, town in Maine.
