Michael Francis Smith is a composer, teacher, band and choir director, and church worship leader. He has taught instrumental music, from elementary bands up to community bands, ranging in ages from 9 to 90. He is a graduate of Ithaca College where he studied composition with Karel Husa. His Master of Education Degree is in School Administration from Lesley College; for 23 years he was a K-12 Music Department Chair in two Massachusetts school districts. He is one of the founders and conductors of the Abington Community Band.

After 26 years of public school teaching, he is focusing on composing, song and hymn writing, and leading church worship. His music tells a story, finding inspiration in hymns and spirituals, patriotic music, poetry and classic literature. He often combines instrumental and vocal scores to be used by any combination of band, chorus and orchestra, or to be played or sung successfully by any ensemble alone, providing versatility for ensembles and opportunities for concert finales.
