Section A begins with a dynamic f . The Flute has a prominent melodic line. The section ends with a forte dynamic, followed by a repeat sign and two endings.

Sections B and C continue the rhythmic pattern established in section A. The Flute maintains its melodic line, while the other instruments provide harmonic and rhythmic support. The bassoon's role becomes more prominent in section C.
