**Allegro vivacissimo**

This section features five staves: Solo in B $\flat$ , Trumpet 1 in B $\flat$ , Trumpet 2 in B $\flat$ , Horn in F, and Tuba. The Solo part is silent. The other instruments play eighth-note patterns. Dynamics include ff at the beginning and f towards the end.

**Cadenza**

This section features six staves: Solo, B $\flat$  Tpt. 1, B $\flat$  Tpt. 2, Hn., Tbn., and Tuba. The Solo part begins with a short silence before entering with a sixteenth-note pattern. The brass instruments provide harmonic support with sustained notes and eighth-note chords. Dynamics include f.

This section features a single staff for the Solo instrument. It begins with a dynamic p and leads into a crescendo followed by an acceleration (cresc. e accel.). The soloist plays a rapid sixteenth-note pattern.
